Dear Homeowner,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am contacting you with an update on the proposed Inchamore Wind Farm project in Coolea, Co. Cork, a FuturEnergy Ireland and SSE Renewables co-development. As the Community Liaison Officer, my role is to ensure you receive all the information you require and answer any queries that arise regarding this renewable energy project.

Since Newsletter 3, was delivered in September, environmental assessment surveys and studies have continued. In February 2022, a meteorological mast was installed on-site at Inchamore. The installation followed approval of the planning application for the 100-metre met mast that was lodged with Cork County Council. Planning approval for this was granted on August 31, 2021. Its purpose is to measure wind speeds from different directions and at various heights.

As the design and development work on Inchamore Wind Farm progresses, we will share a detailed project brochure and virtual exhibition, which we intend to commence with in late Summer/early Autumn 2022. All updates will also be available on the dedicated project website www.inchamorewindfarm.ie.
