Dear Homeowner,

I hope this letter finds you well.

The project team would like to keep you updated on the proposed Inchamore Wind Farm project, a co-development between Coillte Renewable Energy and SSE Renewables.

Since Newsletter 3, delivered in September, environmental assessment surveys and studies have continued. Over the coming weeks, weather permitting, a 100 metre met mast will be installed at Inchamore. Its purpose is to measure wind speeds from different directions and at various heights. The installation follows approval of our planning application for the 100 metre met mast lodged with Cork County Council, which was granted on August 31, 2021.

Our community engagement team will be back in touch early next year with a detailed project brochure that will provide an overview of all aspects of the proposed wind farm project. The brochure will be complemented by an online Virtual Tour where you can view survey reports and photomontages of the area. All updates will also be uploaded onto the dedicated project website, www.inchamorewindfarm.ie.
